Unloading of merchandise on Town Day, May 20, is between 7-8 a.m. (Please do not come before 7 a.m.) Stop to get your Table Space number at the beginning of Leonard Street. You can unload your car and then park your car in the municipal lot behind the center. Parking is free for the day.

Vendor numbers will be marked on the street. Odd numbers are on the right, even numbers on the left, or you can call Champion Sporting Goods at 617-489-4930 and get your table space number beginning on Tuesday, May 16, 2023.

Please Note: This is a family fun day, there will be no selling of any offensive items (i.e., snap caps, water guns, silly string, stink bombs, shaving cream, etc.) and if you do sell them, you will be asked to leave immediately and will not be allowed back for a future Town Day.
